Kenworth has received orders for the T680 from major fleets to owner-operators. The Kenworth T680 is designed to maximize performance in line haul, pickup and delivery, and regional hauling operations. Kenworth initially offered the T680 in day cab or 76-inch sleeper configurations.

Kenworth T680 orders are expected to benefit from the recent addition of the Kenworth T680 52-inch mid-roof sleeper, which is now in production. This option is well-suited for regional hauling applications – including tank, bulk, flatbed, heavy haul and lowboy – where owners are looking for reduced weight to increase payload and where drivers may spend just two or three nights on the road during a typical week.

The T680 is standard with the PACCAR MX-13 engine rated up to 500 hp and 1,850 lb-ft of torque. The PACCAR MX-13 offers excellent fuel efficiency, high reliability and durability, lightweight design, and low cost of ownership. The engine is assembled at the state-of-the-art PACCAR Engine plant in Columbus, Miss.
