Extensive computer diagnostics are used throughout the shop with everything from diesel particulate filter cleaning to major overhaul available. The shop also features a customer-friendly layout with easy access and parking.

Dealer manager, Simeon Hauptman, who will continue to run the new dealership, said he and his staff anxiously awaited the opening. “The entire team and I were very excited to see this day finally arrive,” said Hauptman. “Our new facility offers state-of-the-art amenities for all of our customers, technicians and staff.
