



## Kenworth T680 and T880 Now Available with Dana Spicer D-Series Lightweight Steer Axles

KIRKLAND, Wash. – Kenworth’s T680 and T880 models are now available with Dana Spicer® D-Series lightweight steer axles for use with air disc brakes.



The D-Series axles feature a new lightweight beam with a robust axle-to-brake attachment to help maximize performance. A patented steer arm design further reduces weight, delivering excellent performance within a smaller design envelope.

The axles also feature a new integrated air disc brake knuckle. The knuckle’s one-piece, forged design incorporates the tie-rod arm, disc brake mounting feature and spindle, and eliminates the need for a separate torque plate and its associated fasteners. The new axle weighs approximately 35 pounds less than the previous lightweight beam axle and torque plate assembly.
